Grammar - Know that in English the pronoun "I" always has a capital letter but, in French, "je" only has a capital letter if it is at the beginning of a sentence.

Know that "je" becomes "j'" where the next word starts with a vowel (j'ai, j'aime)

Know that "le" or "la" are "l'" before a vowel.

Know that nouns can be singular (one thing) or plural (more than one thing). In English and French, the most common way to show that a noun is plural is by adding an "s" at the end (examples should mainly use nouns with regular plural endings).

Know that the pronouns 'il' and 'elle' are used in French to mean "it". The gender of the noun decides whether "il" or "elle" is used.
